I have in and to said negro and I do

defend the title to said negro man to
said James Coltharp his heirs and assigns
forever and also to warrant the said
negro man to be sound in body and
mind and allane for life as witness
my hand and seal using a scribble for
seal this 1st day of January A.D. 1863
