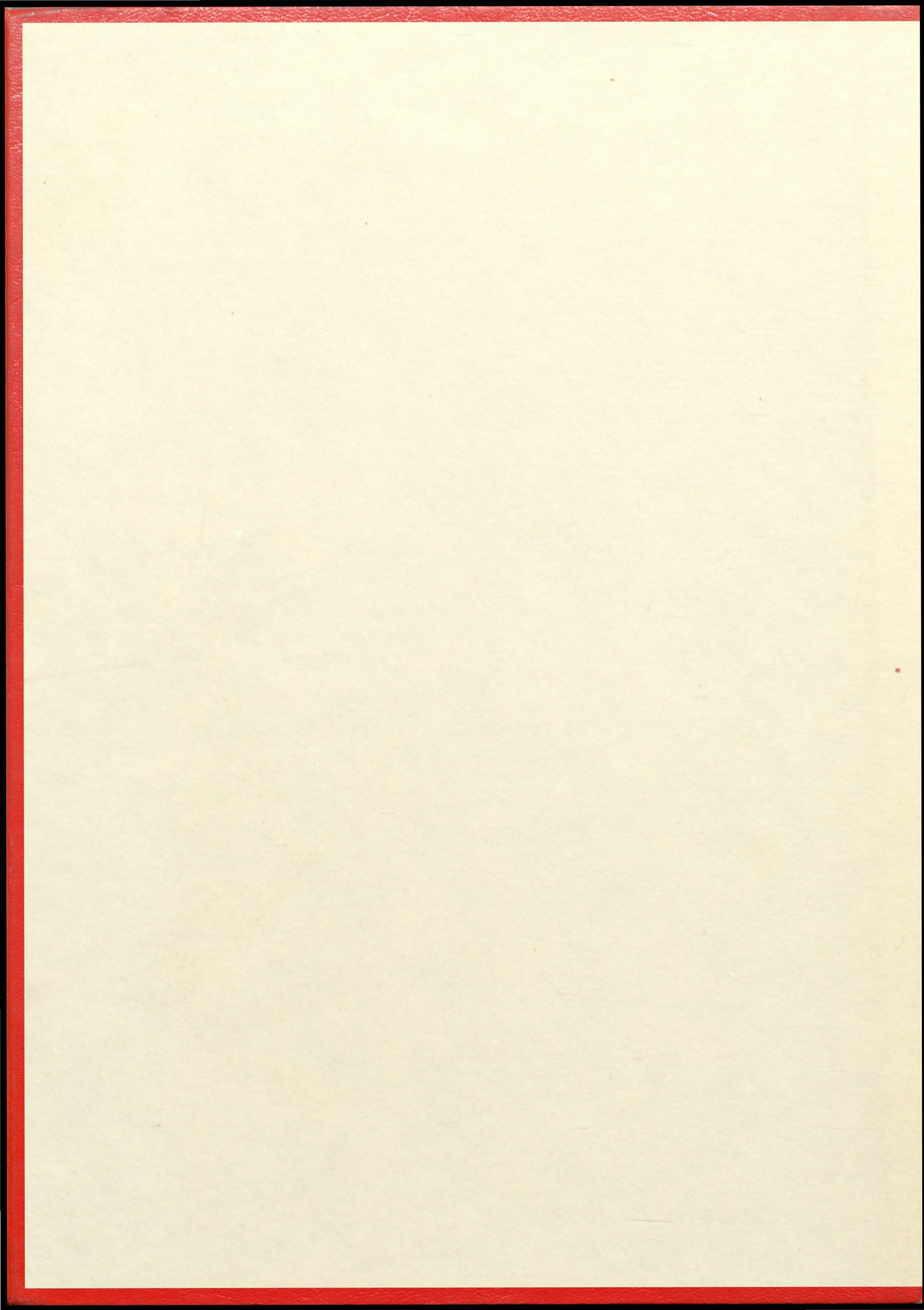
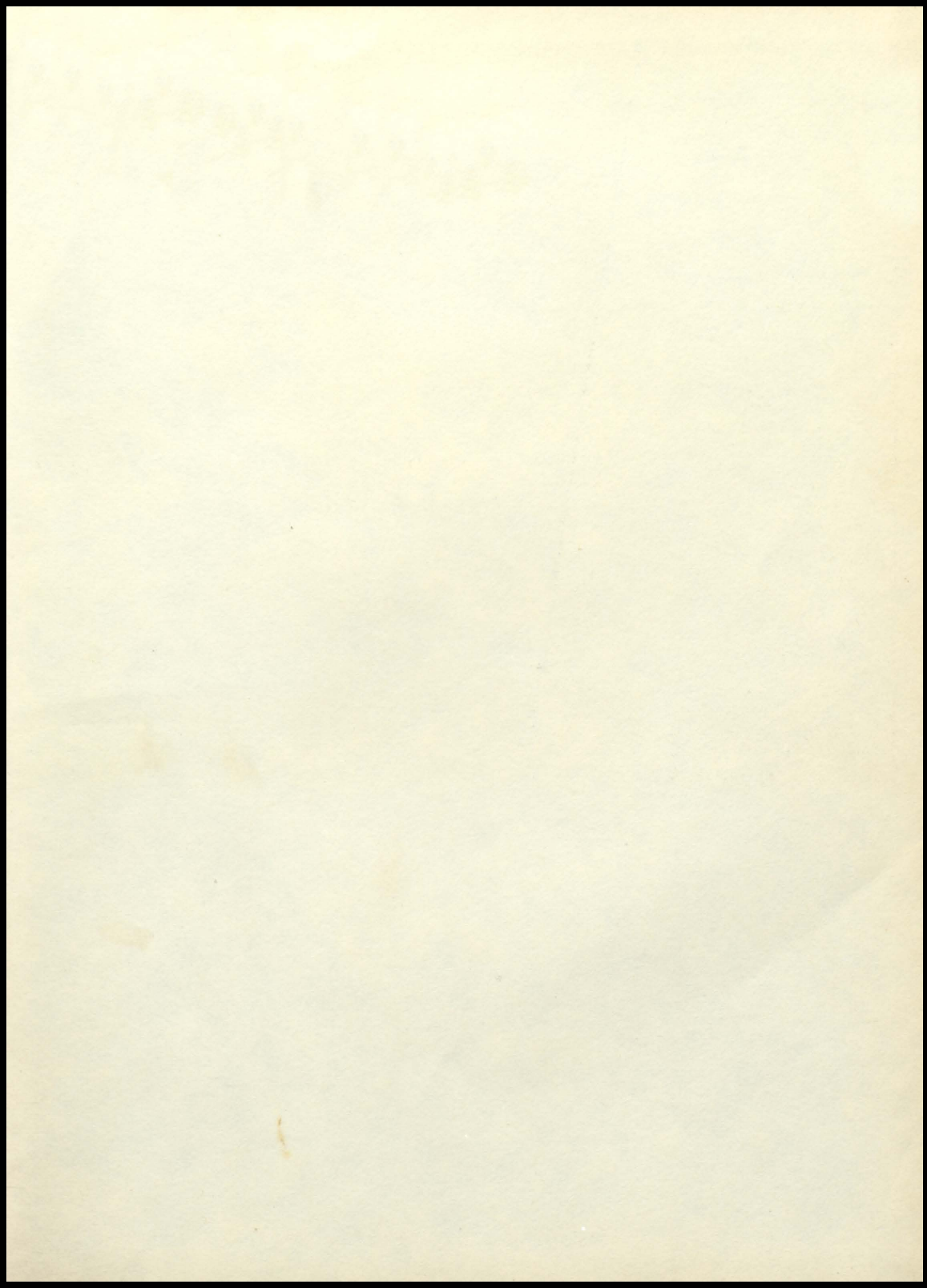


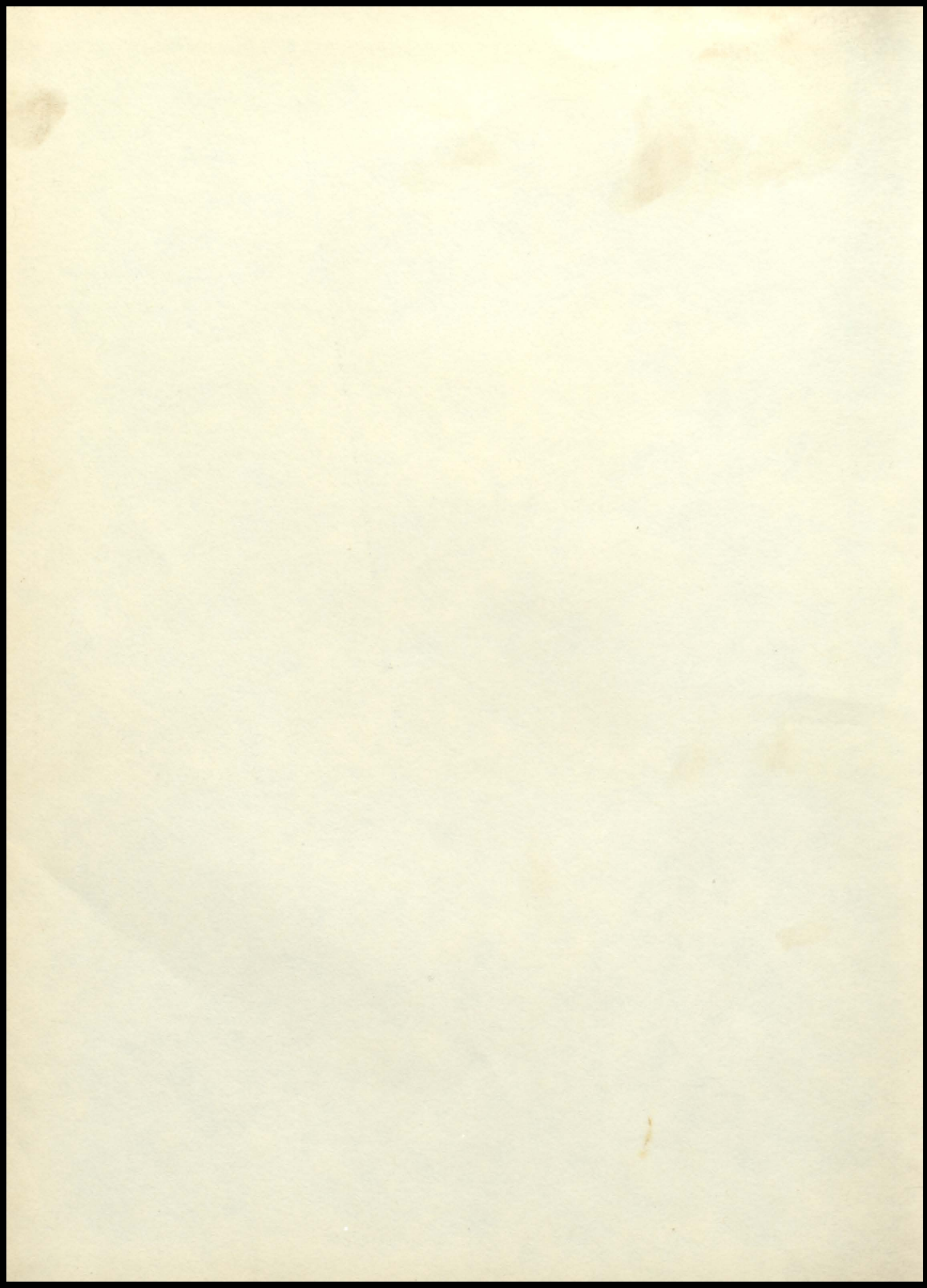

MISS CORDIA GEORGE

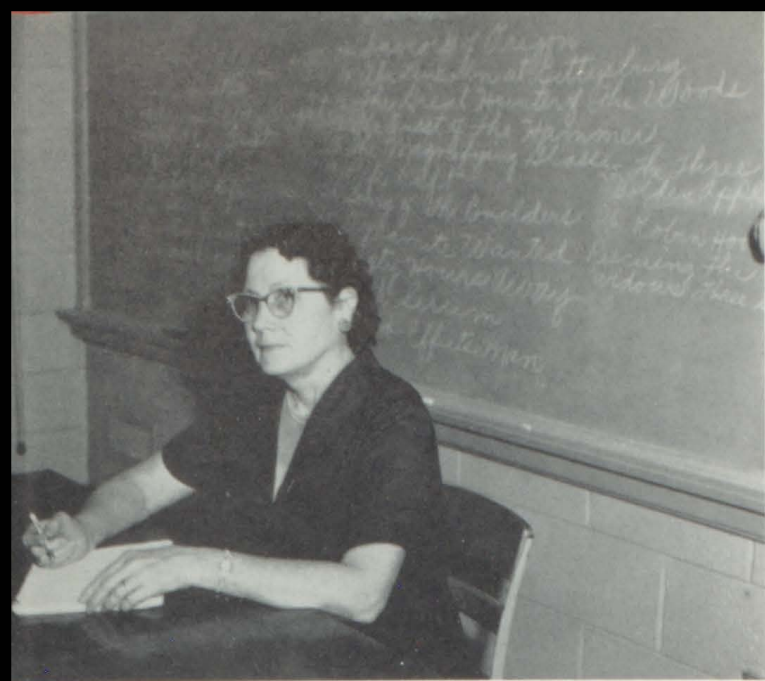
She is a native of Athens - Has a B. A. Degree from North Texas. She teaches Ninth Grade English. She likes to work with children. Her hobby is cooking.

In addition to introducing us to the principles that govern our biological and physical worlds, science teaches us to think clearly and for ourselves in a critical, self-reliant manner.



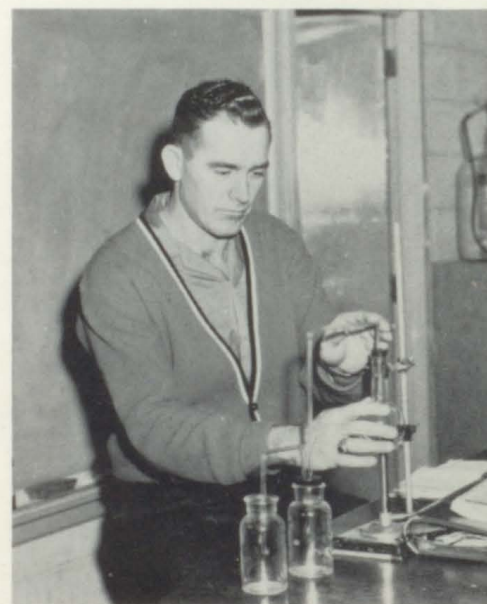
MR. BILLY RUSHING

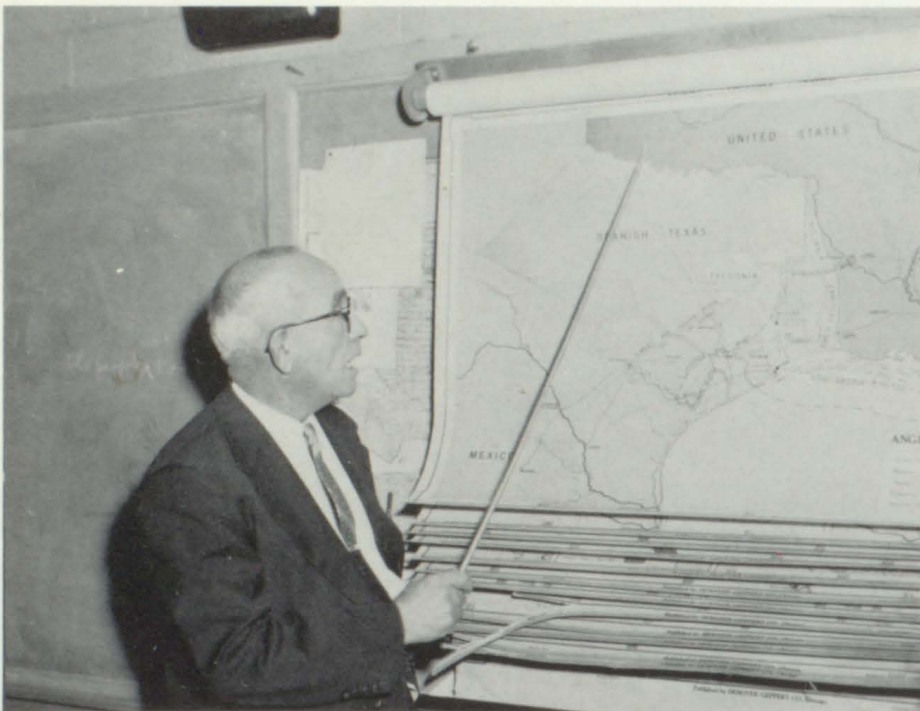


MRS. GLENN FLUKER

This is our librarian. She has a B. A. and Master of Library Science from TWU. She likes to cook and read.

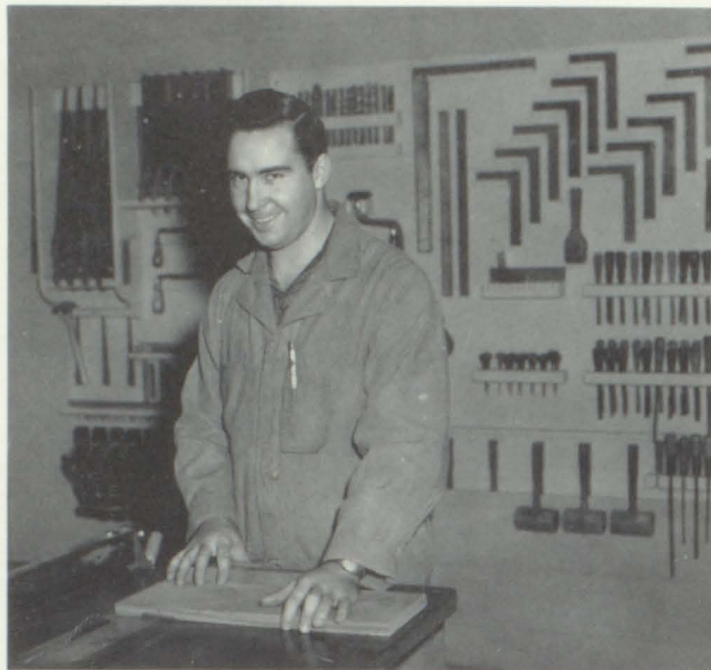
MRS. MELVIN STEIFEL

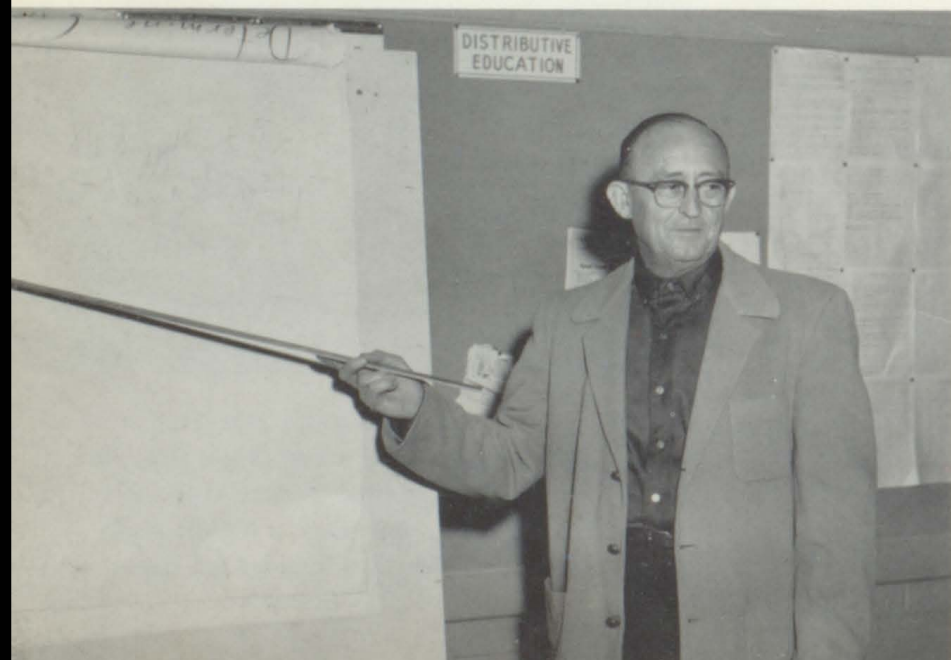
Vocational Courses Train

He teaches Distributive Education. Has M. E. and B. A. Degrees from S. M. U. His hobby is cooking.

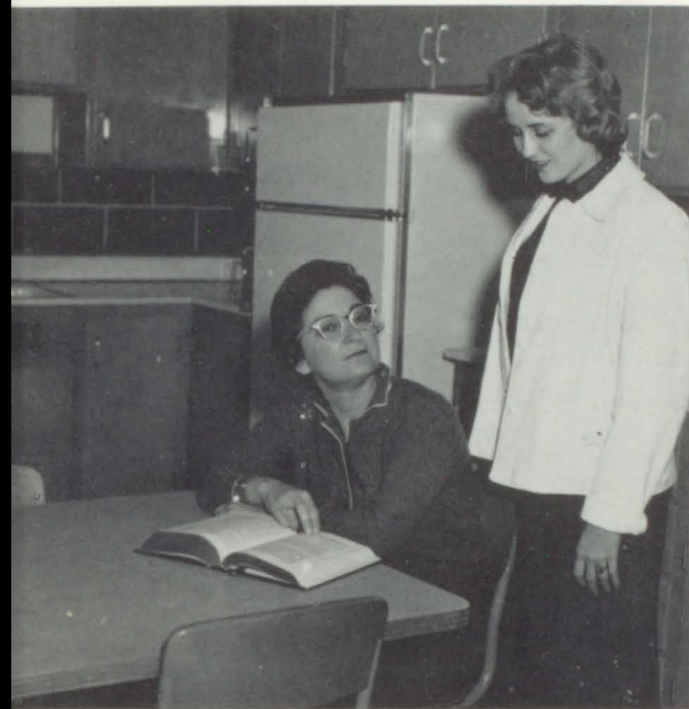
MRS. IRIS LOCKEY

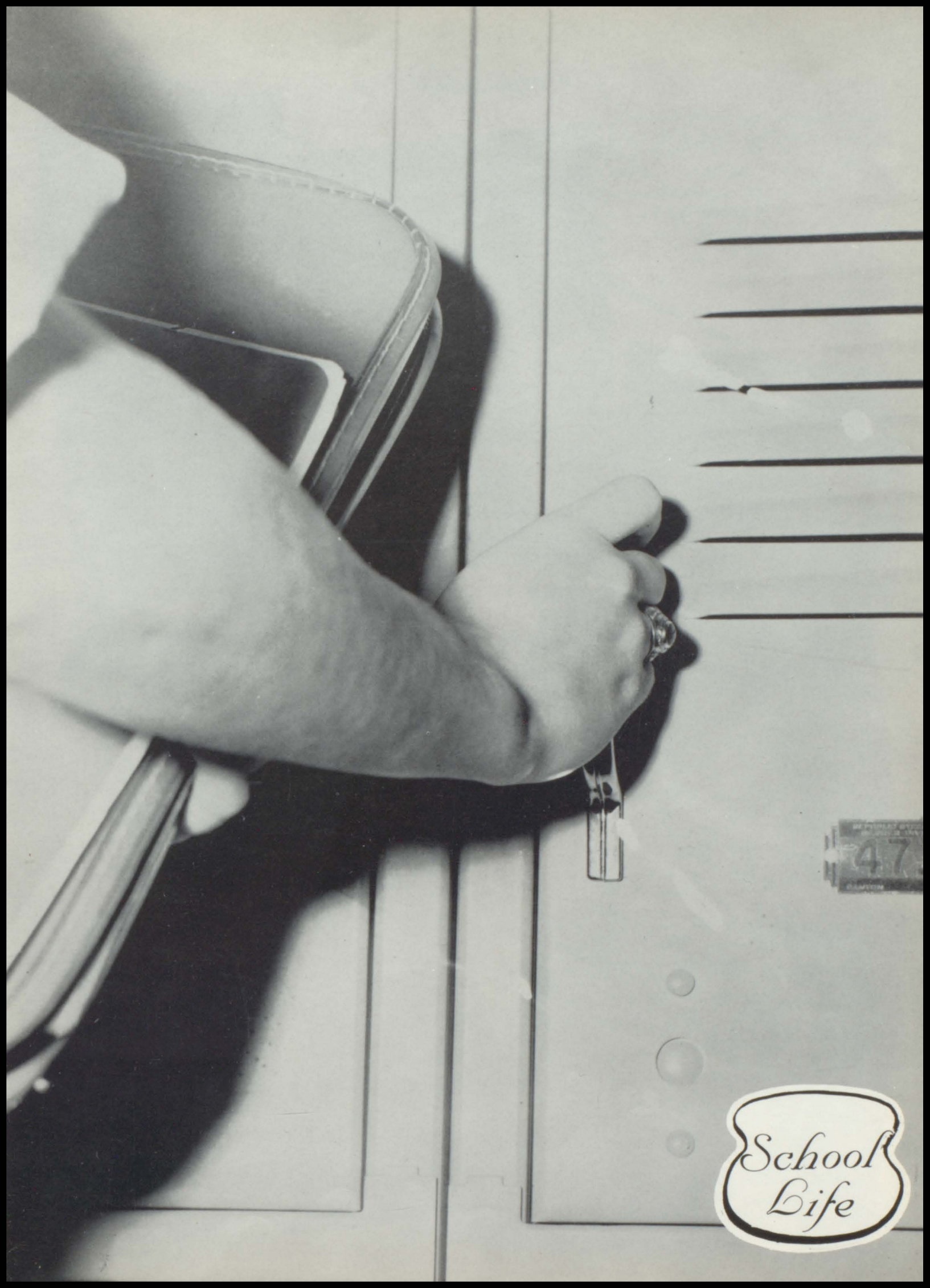
What Our Clubs Help Us Do
