



MISS CORDIA GEORGE


She is a native of Athens - Has a B. A. Degree from North Texas. She teaches Ninth Grade English. She likes to work with children. Her hobby is cooking.

Math and Science Teach Us to Think Clearly


In addition to introducing us to the principles that govern our biological and physical worlds, science teaches us to think clearly and for ourselves in a critical, self-reliant manner.


The various clubs of our school that you have seen in the preceeding pages show the many different types of things that we excell in.
