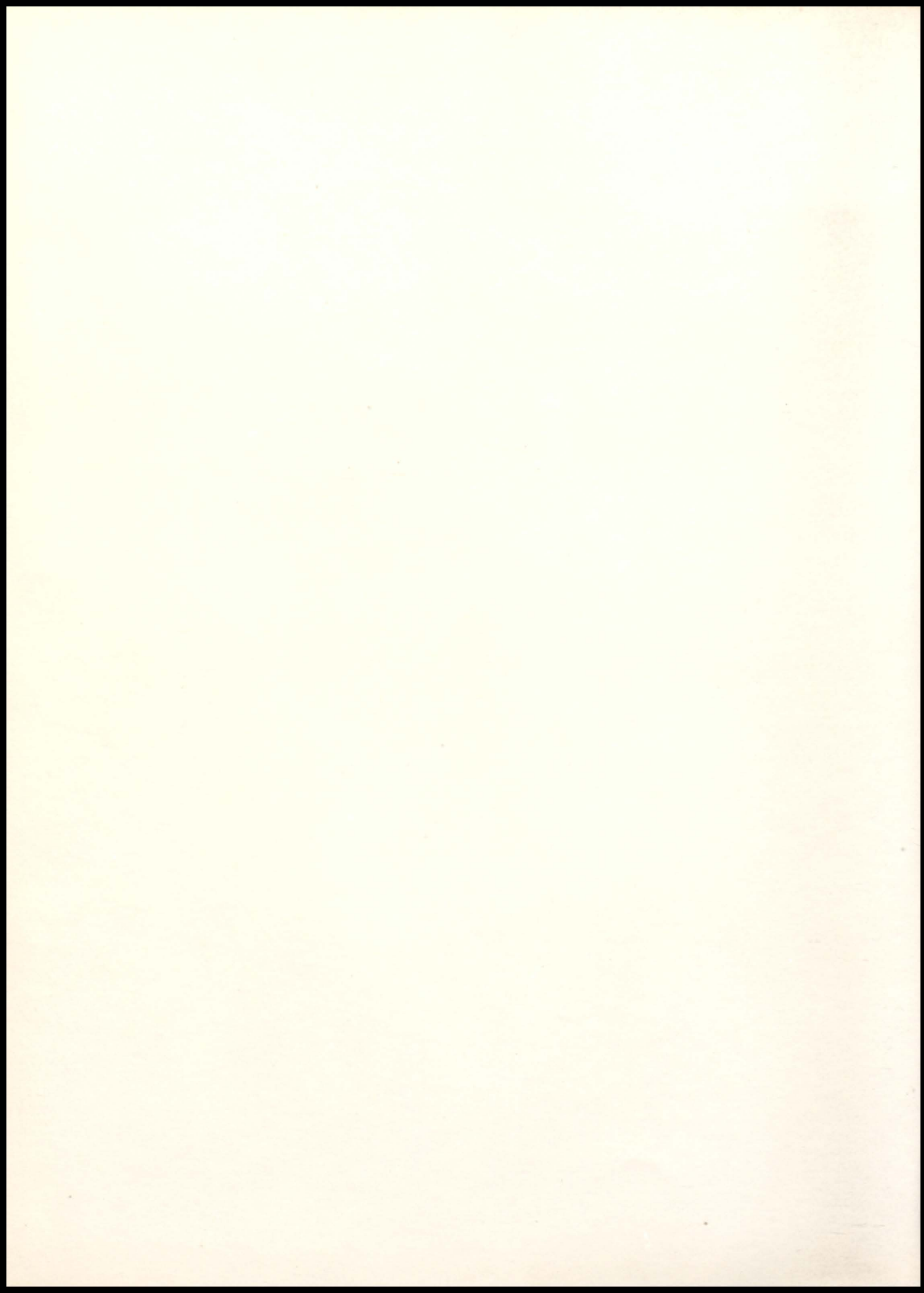


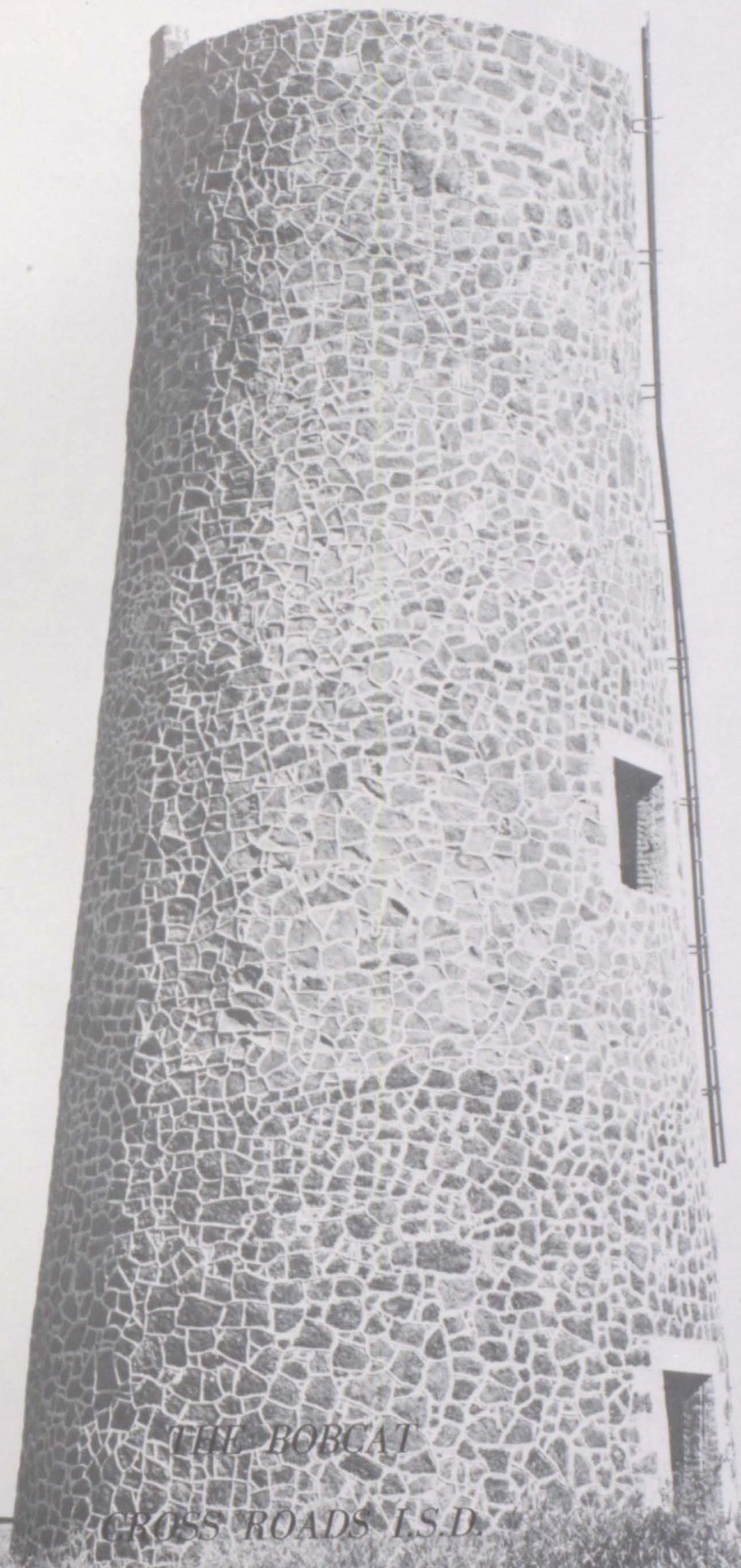

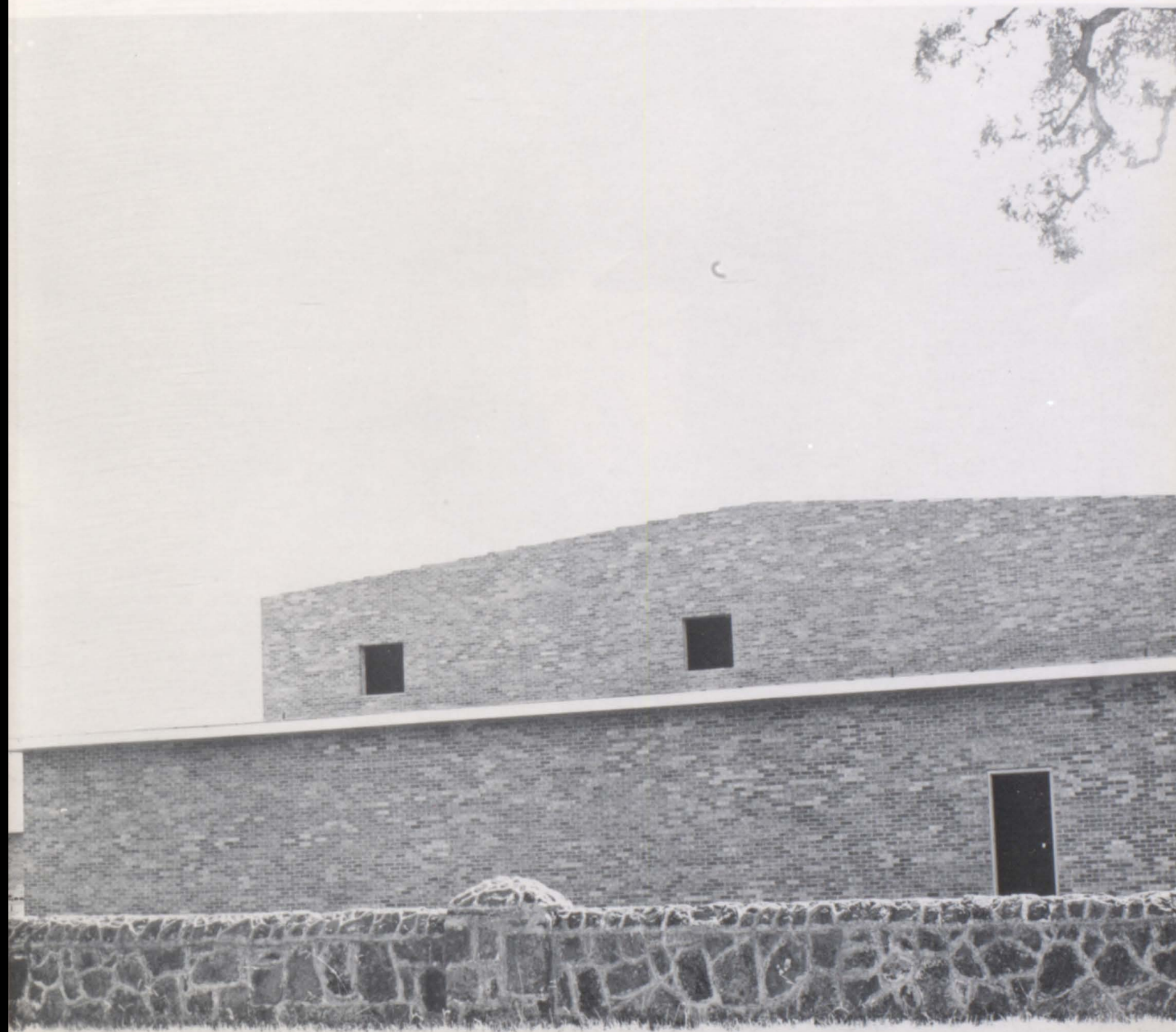
CROSS—ROADS
