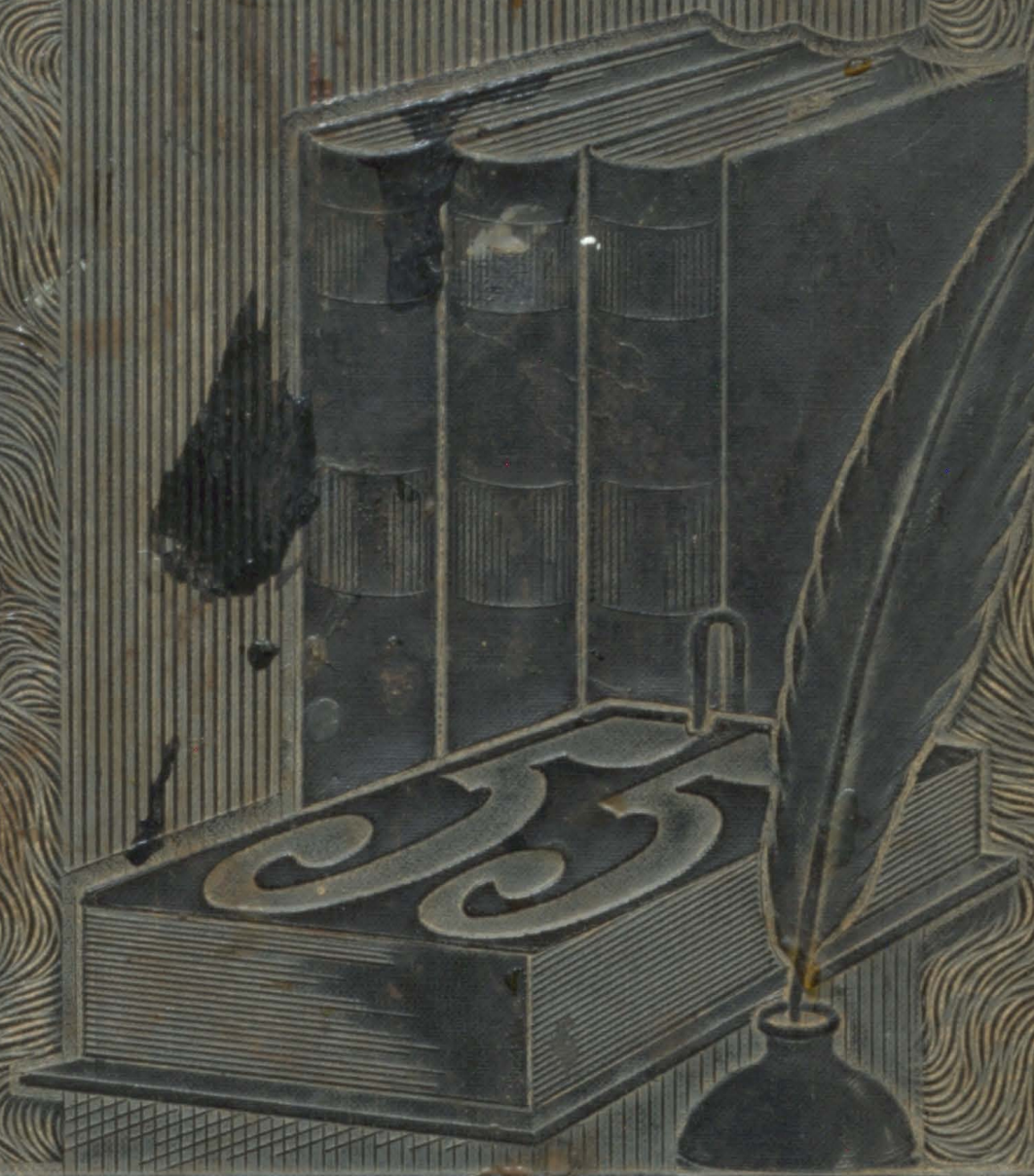

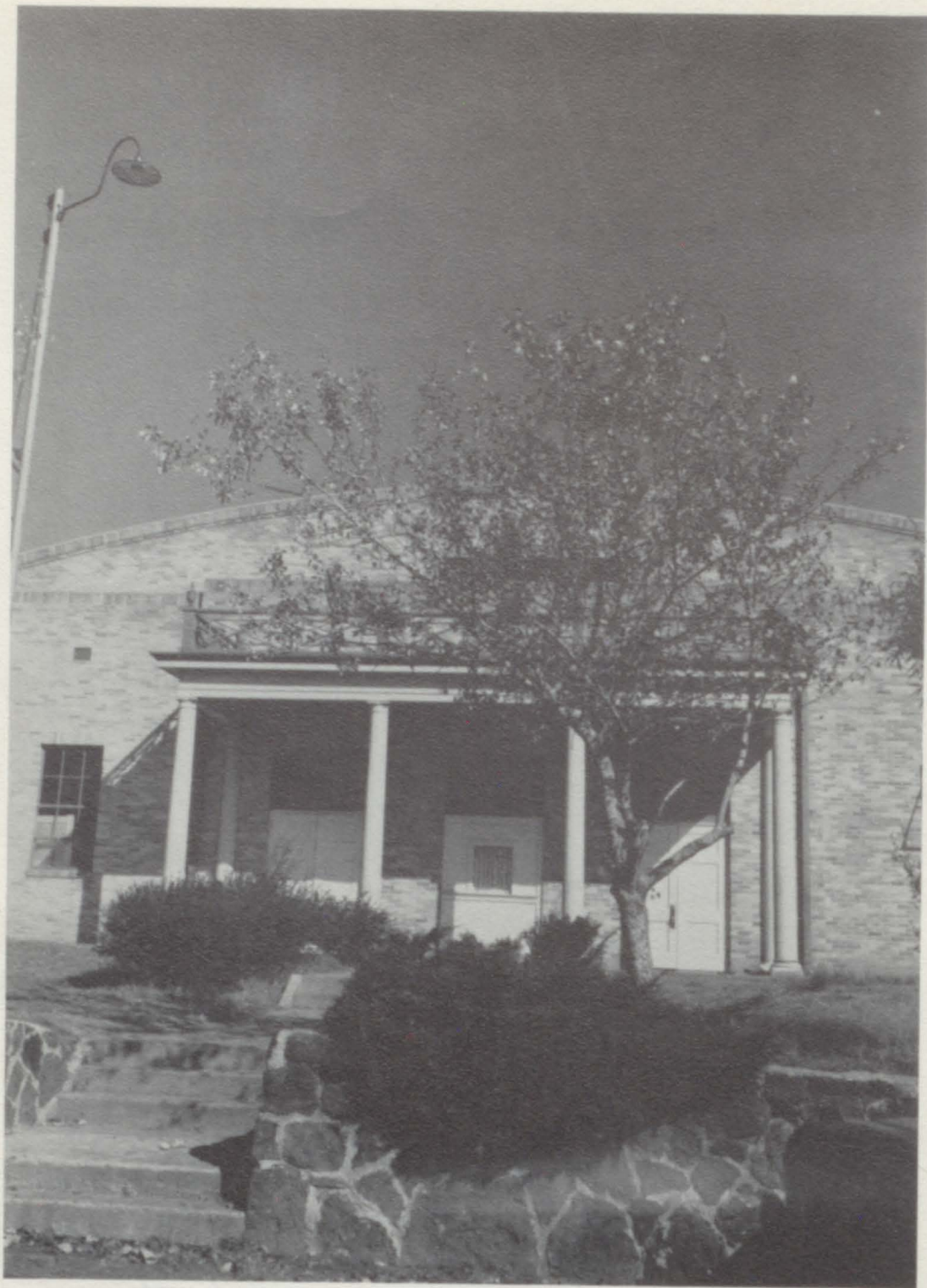


### MISS GEORGIA STEPHEN
