




#### MISS GEORGIA STEPHEN

Because she likes us, we like her, and so we are al happy to dedicate this edition of THE TIGER to Miss Georgia Stephen, commercial teacher!






#### MALAKOFF HIGH GYMNASIUM




Winning banners is a favorite pastime of the vocational agriculture classes ... the wall of their building is covered with them!
