We recognize that our nation, its leaders, and we, as individuals have faltered and made wrong decisions, but we have also triumphed in moments of great uncertainty.

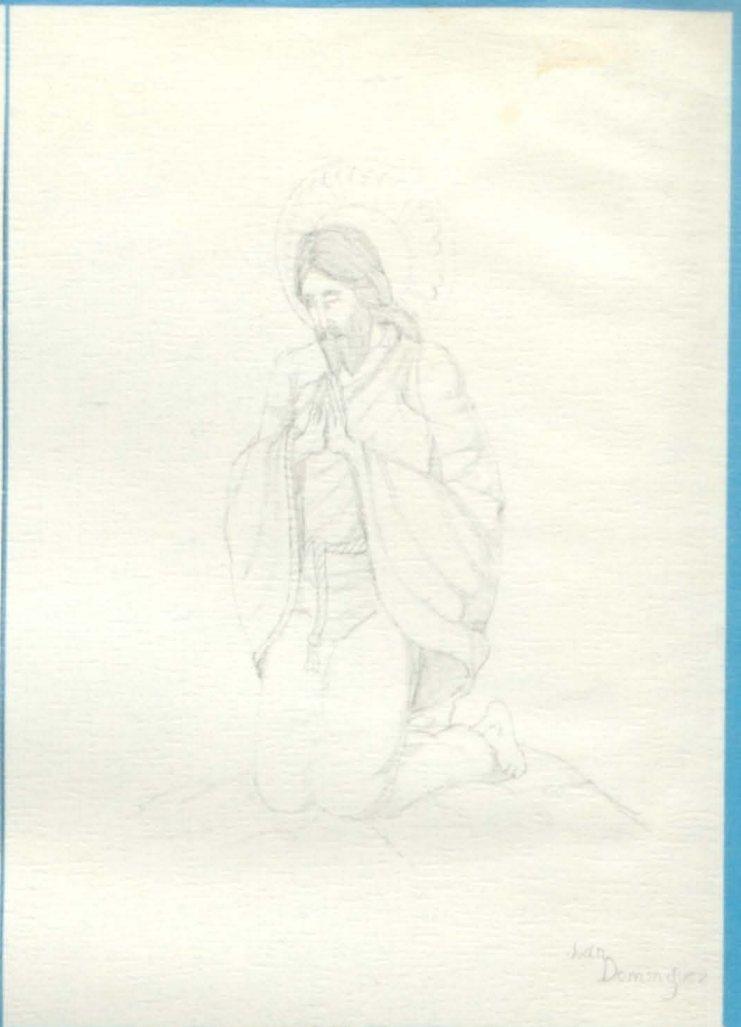

# Our Administration



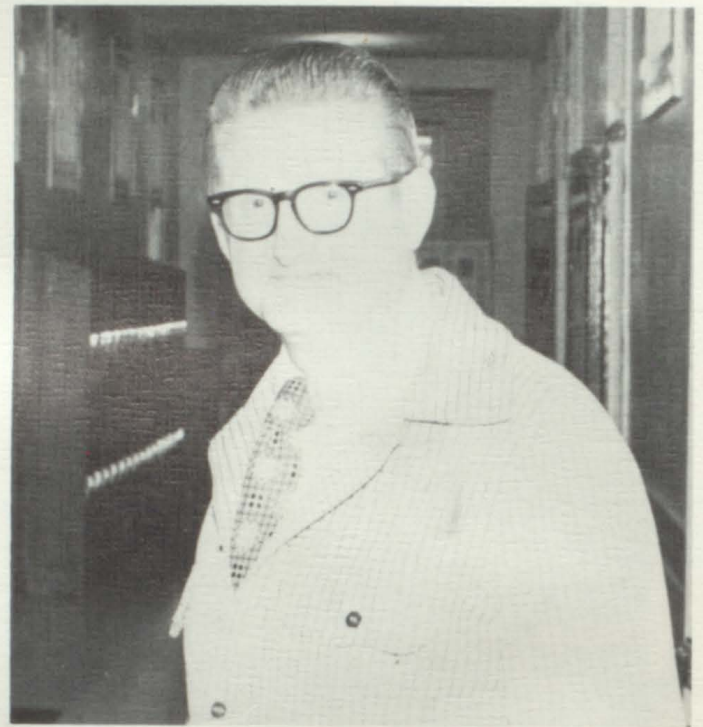
