SUCCESS AT LAST!

It has been a long since since the Trinidad Trojans even thought about being able to make it into the play-offs at the end of the season. In fact, for the past several years, the main goal has been just to survive the season without too many injuries and possibly win 3 or 4 games at the same time.

The Trojans of 1985, under the leadership of Coaches DuBose and Jaggars brought many words back into the vocabulary of Trinidad students and fans — words like "winning," "touchdowns," and even the undreamed of word "play-offs."

"We wiped 'em out last Friday night," "Trinidad's Double-Truck Strikes Again," and "Can you believe that run?" became familiar sayings as the season progressed.

The losses to Italy and Maypearl set the Trojans back a little, but playoff hopes were still alive in the toss of the coin.
