

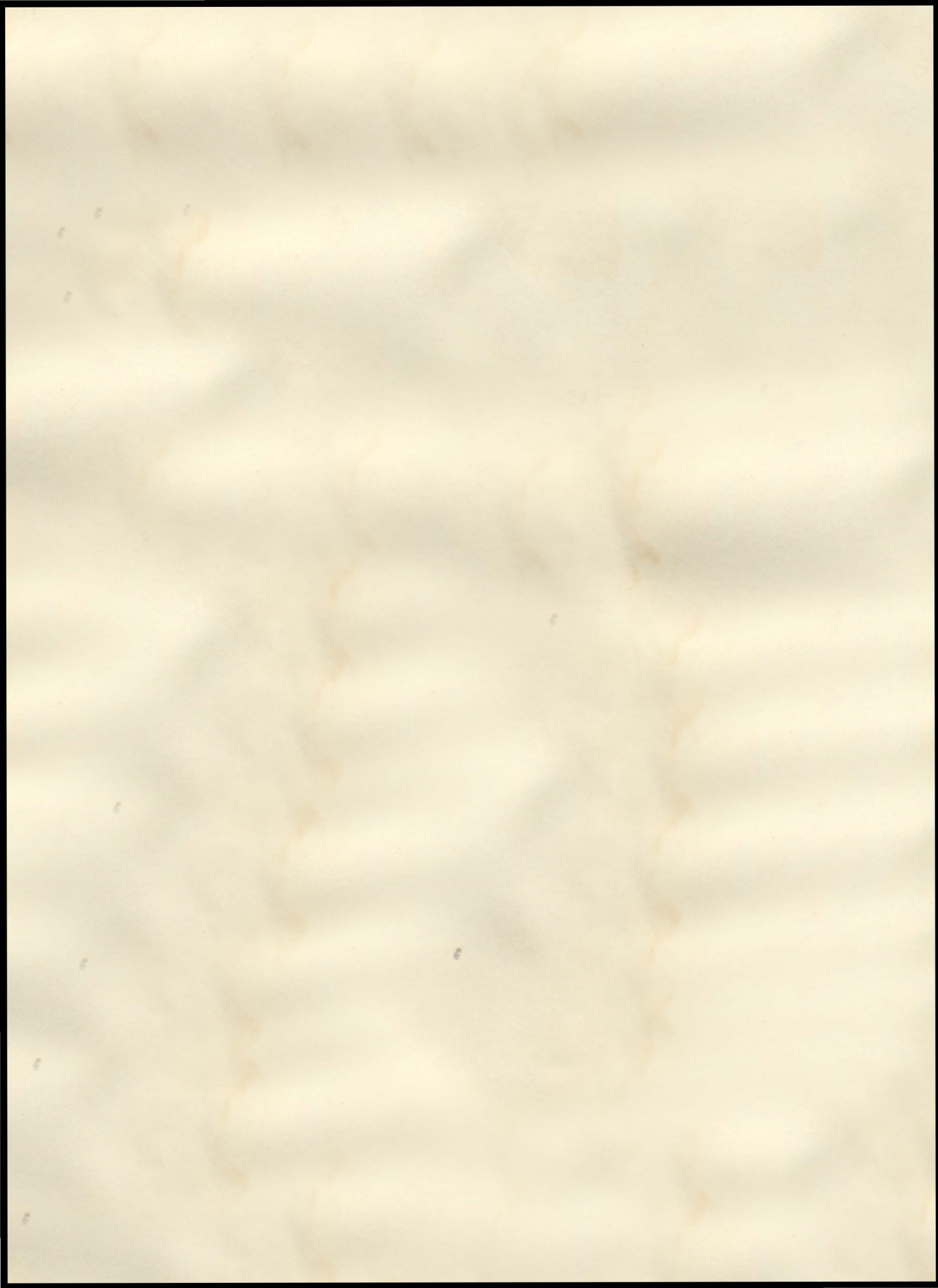

Because of his accomplishments with the students of THS, we dedicate the 1986 TROJAN to Coach Davy DuBose.



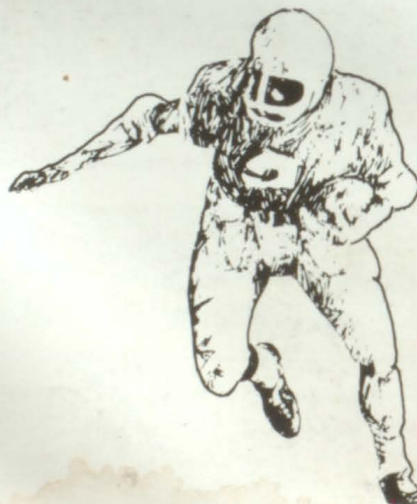

Following the awards presentation, a dance was held in the gym, with Kevin Carter acting as deejay.



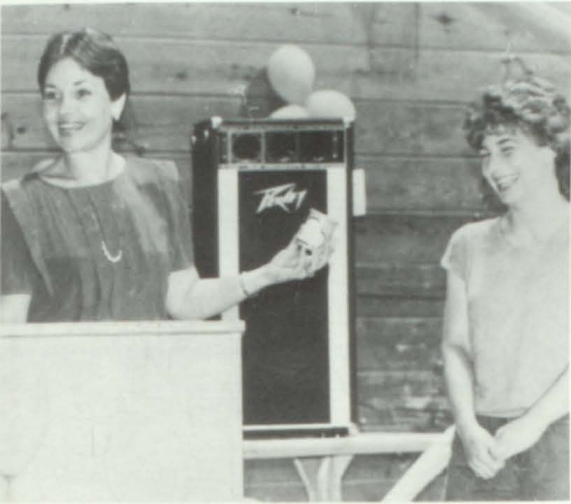
