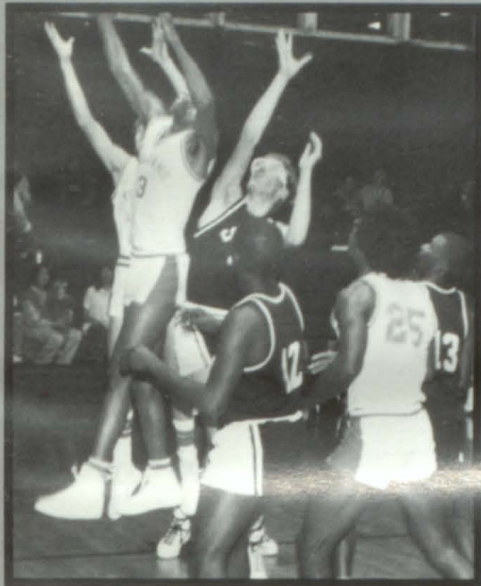


On April 1, 1987, a great tragedy came to Trinidad students when Billy Diepenbruck died.

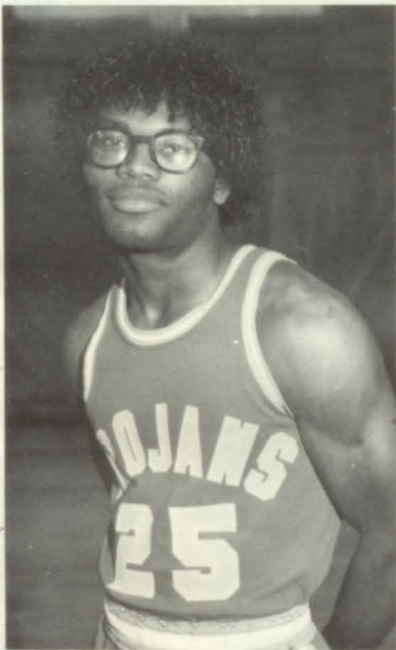
BI-DISTRICT CHAMPS

For new coach Ray Vanderford and the boys' basketball team, the 1986-87 season was one of many successes.

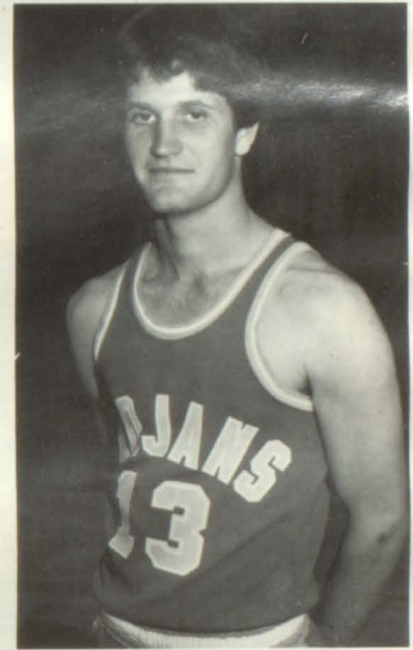

Unfortunately, Avalon outscored the Trojans, thus ending the 1987 season with an attractive 25-8 record.

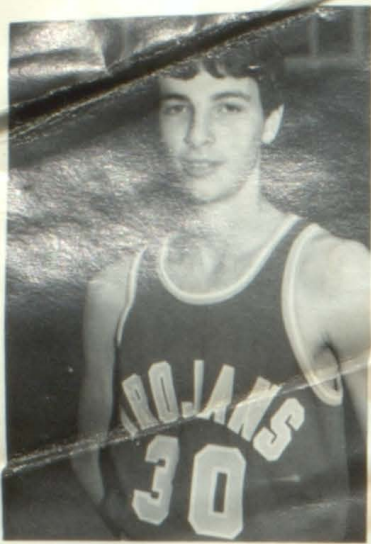
