Losing eight seniors from the team will cause Coach Jones to create a new game plan for 1988.

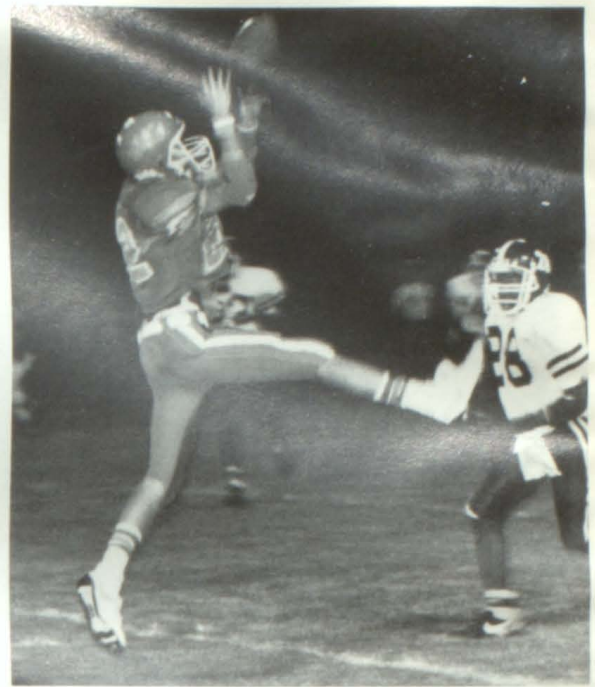

However, Oakwood got the upper hand in the bi-district game, defeating the Trojans 56-43, eliminating them from advancement.

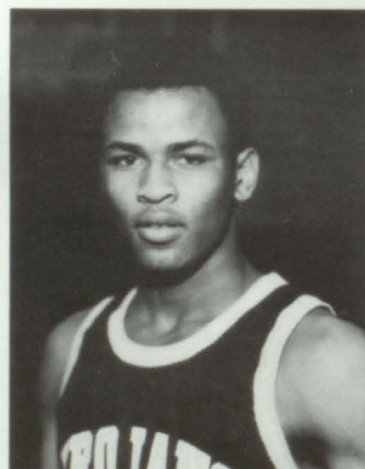
