## Civil War ledger presented to HCHC

A ledger containing the annual reunion minutes of the Crockett Boys Association of Confederate Veterans from their first meeting in 1911 through the last meeting in 1917 was presented to the Houston County Historical Commission by Chester Roy Julian at the Dec. 21 meeting.

The ledger was handed down to Julian by his great-grandfather W. F. Julian who was elected "Secretary for Life" in the veterans'

organization.

A 1911 photograph of 16 veterans, with identifications attached, was also given to the historical commission.

The Crockett Boys were veterans of Company I, 4<sup>th</sup> Texas Mounted Volunteers, Sibley's (Green's) Brigade, under the command of Captain D. A. Nunn.
