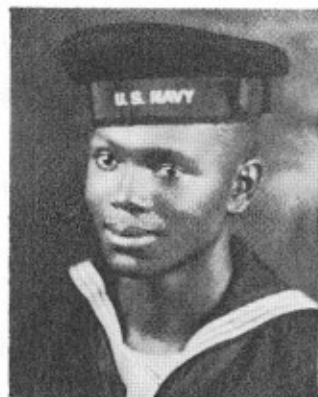


BENTON, LEVI

Pfc. Carl Byrd, Rt. 3, Box 194, Crockett. Entered Army, 1941, trained in Mo. and Fla. Served in CBI. Awarded Purple Heart, 2 Battle Stars and GCM. Wounded on Burma Road, 1942. Discharged in 1944.

**CRAWFORD, IVORY**
