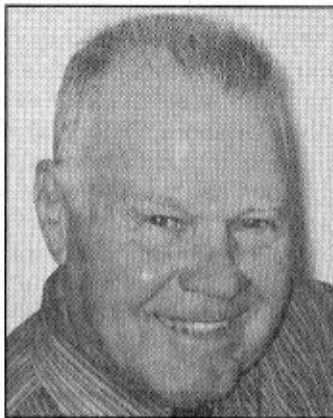


Floyd Leroy Garver
