Funeral services for Judy Pennington Rowan, 67, were held on Saturday, March 3, 2007 in Greenwood Chapel, Fort Worth. Interment followed in the Greenwood Memorial Park with arrangements under the direction of Greenwood Funeral Home.

Mrs. Rowan passed away Wednesday, Feb. 28, 2007. She was born July 17, 1939, in Waco. As a young child she lived in dozens of Texas towns before her family settled permanently in Grapeland. In Grapeland, she was a member of the Methodist church and attended Grapeland High School, where she graduated as class valedictorian. Judy went back to work in the 1980's, when she opened a boutique with her business partner, Joan Anderson. She enjoyed fishing, loved to play bridge and backgammon, and was a member of the Fort Worth Junior Women's Club. Above all she will be remembered as a devoted and loving wife and mother.
