

Nolan Young Scoggin

The memorial services for Mr. Nolan Young Scoggin, age 85, of San Marcos, were held at 3 p.m., October 7, 2007, at Sunrise Village No. 2 Recreation Center in San Marcos, TX. Interment of ashes will be held in East Texas at a later date.

Mr. Scoggin passed away on September 16, 2007, after a short illness. He was born May 24, 1922, in Percilla, TX, where he grew up. In 1947, he was signed by the Chicago Cubs as pitcher, but never made it to his first major league game due to an arm injury. He served in the U.S. Navy during WW II. He moved to Houston, TX after his military service. Nolan was employed by Rath Packing Company for 31 years and, upon retirement, moved to El Rito, NM with his wife, Evelyn, and youngest son, Eric, where he enjoyed gardening, landscaping and hunting. He and his wife moved back to the Central Texas area in 1995, where they enjoyed time spent with their children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
