Mr. Russell Van Horne, age 69 of Pearsons Chapel, passed away Sunday, July 8, 2007 in the East Texas Medical Center-Crockett. Mr. Van Horne was born June 20, 1938 in Wheeling, West Virginia and lived here for the past 13 years. Mr. Van Horne worked as an electrician for Union Pacific Railroad retiring after 42 years of service in 2002 and served on the Palestine Union-Pacific Safety and Health Board.
