Mr. James L. Milton, age 89 of Huntingburg, Indiana passed away at 4:07 a.m. Sunday, May 30, 2010 in the emergency room of Memorial Hospital and Health Care Center in Jasper. Mr. Milton was born on December 20, 1920 in Huntingburg, Indiana to Daniel R. and Catherine (Krueger) Milton. He was united in marriage to Janice M. McClure on February 4, 1950 at the Methodist Church in Huntingburg. He was a retired furniture sales representative.

Mr. Milton served in the Armed Guard of the U.S. Navy during WW II and was part of the D-Day invasion at Normandy. He was a member of the Huntingburg United Methodist Church, Y.M.I. Club, Huntingburg High School Class of 1939, American Legion Post #147; was a charter member of the V.F.W. Post #2366, actively serving on the Memorial Honor Detail and formerly served two terms as Post Commander in 1950 and 2000; was a tour guide at the Huntingburg League Stadium; and acted in the role as an umpire in the movie "A League of Their Own".

Survivors include his son Keith Milton, of Huntingburg, Ind.

Preceded in death by his wife Janice M. Milton, passed away November 29, 2005; six brothers Charles, Walter, Ralph, Hilbert, Arthur, and Elmer Milton; and three sisters Mildred Andrews, Geneva Elshoff, and Frances Henderson.
