Mr. Wade Lewis Pennington, age 86 of Grapeland, passed away Saturday, March 20, 2010 at Cartmell Home for Aged in Palestine. Mr. Pennington was born near Hayes Springs Com-munity, west of Grapeland, on April 20, 1923, the youngest son of Daniel Boone Pennington and Ada Viola Ward Pennington. Mr. Pennington was part of a pioneer Houston County family whose roots here date back to the mid 1800s. His great-great-grandmother was Hannah Boone Pennington, a sister of the legendary Daniel Boone of Kentucky.

Mr. Pennington graduated from Grapeland High School in 1941 where he excelled in academics. He married the love of ohis life on September 21, 1942. On February 12, 1943 he entered the US Army where he served his country in World War II. He was stationed in the Phillipines, Luzon and other bases in the Pacific until February 22, 1946. He returned to ary 22, 1946. He returned to Grapeland and began his farming and ranching career which spanned over 70 years.

Mr. Pennington was a member of the First Baptist Church, Grapeland. He was one of the original founders of the Grapeland Coop, and served as president. He was also director for many years of the Houston County ASCS. He was a member of the Texas-Oklahoma Watermelon Association and the Texas Angus Association.
