Mr. Glen Robert Alford, age 85 of Crockett, passed away Tuesday, January 10, 2006 in the Mya Nursing Home in Palestine. Mr. Alford was born May 27, 1920 in Creek to Guy and Tina Mae Alford and was a resident of Houston County for most of his life. Mr. Alford enlisted in the U.S. Navy immediately following the attack of Pearl Harbor and spent over two years in the South Pacific as a radioman on a destroyer. Mr. Alford's ship participated in several battles including Guadalcanal and the Midway Islands and he was discharged on October 3, 1945 as a Third Class Petty Officer. Mr. Alford was retired and had worked as a truck driver and was a member of the Austonio Baptist Church.

Survivors include his sister Mamie Dean, of Pasadena; brother Donald Alford, of Poway, Calif.; seven nieces; six nephews.

Preceded in death by his wife **Bonnie** Alford; parents **Guy Alford** and **Tina Mae Barbee Alford**; brother **Guy Alford**; and sisters **Irma Douglass** and **Ella Mae Smith**.
