TRINITY -- Services for Trinity native Richard Arthur Anderson, 55, were held at 2 p.m. Sunday, Dec. 28, 2003, at the Trinity Funeral Home.

Mr. Anderson died Tuesday, Dec. 23, in a Houston hospital.

He was born Sept. 22, 1948, in Trinity and was a graduate of Trinity High School where he participated in many athletic and other extracurricular activities.
