TRINITY -- Services for Charles Eugene Arnold, 85, of Trinity were held at 10 a.m. Saturday, June 15, 2001, in the Waller-Thornton Funeral Home in Trinity with the Rev. Leroy Brown officiating.

Burial followed in the Glendale Memorial Cemetery with member of the Joe Werner Masonic Lodge of Trinity conducting graveside services.

Mr. Arnold died Wednesday, June 12, at his residence.
