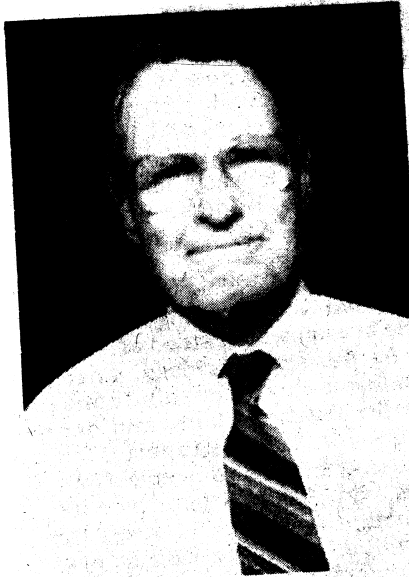

## Services To Be Held Today For George Badgett

Funeral services for George H. Badgett, age 76, of Grapeland will be held this afternoon (Thursday) at 1:00 p.m. in the Felders Chapel Assembly of God Church with Rev. Randy Shipman officiating. Burial will follow in Davis Cemetery under the direction of Bailey & Foster, Grapeland.

George Henry Badgett, Jr. went to be with his Lord Jesus Christ Tuesday, March 7, 2000, at his home. Badgett and Lola Irene McCray Badgett. Mr. Badgett was retired from Exxon as a welder. A member and deacon at Felders Chapel Assembly of God, he was a dedicated member and president of the Grapeland Area Men's prayer Group. Mr. Badgett was a veteran of World War II, serving with the U. S. Air Force. He was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.
