Mrs. Edna "Ted" Smith Barbee, age 91 of Crockett passed away Monday, Feb. 28, 2000 at the Houston County Nursing Home in Crockett.

Mrs. Barbee was born Nov. 3, 1908 in Fairdale and had been a resident of Crockett since 1932. She was a graduate of Hemphill High School, class of 1925; received her associate of arts degree from South Park jr.
