### Frank Eugene Beachler

TRINITY - Graveside military funeral services for Frank Eugene Beachler, 75, of Trinity were presented at 9:30 a.m. Monday, June 24, 2002, in the Houston National Cemetery.

Mr. Beachler died Friday, June 21, at his residence in Trinity.

He was born in Roe, Ark., and enlisted in the U.S. Army three times. He served in the Armored Recon Division for nine years, including service during the Korean Conflict.

Mr. Beachler was known as a great mechanic who could repair automobiles, trucks, tractors, trailers and almost anything with an engine.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Tomie.
