

## Monna J. Blackstock

TRINITY - A private Christian graveside service for Monna J. Blackstock, 95, of Trinity was held at 2 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 17, 2002 at the Erath Garden of Memory in Stephenville.

Mrs. Blackstock died Jan. 16 in Trinity.

She was born Feb. 21, 1906 in East Liverpool, Ohio. She was a past president, vice president and secretary of the Houston Garden Club and worked as the private secretary for Bishop Quinn of the Houston Episcopal Diocese Southwestern Division.

She also worked with facial maxillary patients in restoring facial features for those injured by accidents, disfigured by disease and involved in World War II bombings. She worked with her husband, Dr. A.T. Blackstock and helped form the American Dental Prosthetic Organization.

Mrs. Blackstock was a licensed tailor and clothing designer and made the colorful jackets for the Dallas Cowboys football organization. An avid professional oil painter, she displayed her art work in various shows across the state.
