WATERTOWN, S.D. -- Services for Carroll Eugene Brandriet, 70, of Trinity and formerly of Watertown, S.D., were held at 10 a.m. Saturday, Nov. 17, 2001, in St. Joseph Catholic Church in Waverly, S.D.

Mr. Brandriet died Saturday, Nov. 10, at his Trinity residence.

He was born May 30, 1931, at Waverly, S.D., the son of Albert and Ethel (Corey) Brandriet and attended school in Waverly and the Immaculate Conception School in Watertown.

He was married to Shirley E. Goodman on June 3, 1950 in Watertown, S.D. and served in the U.S. Air Force from Feb. 6, 1951 to Jan. 31, 1955. He attended the Military Police Academy at Camp Gordon, Ga. and served at Selfridge, Mich., and Gander Air Force Base in Newfoundland. He was awarded the National Defense Service Medal and the Good Conduct Medal.

Following his discharge, Mr. Brandriet returned to Watertown, S.D. where he owned Carroll's Texaco.

He moved to Texas in 1971 and was a member of the Most Holy Trinity Catholic Church in Trinity, where he sang in the choir.

He enjoyed gardening and outdoor sports.

Mr. Brandriet was preceded in death by his parents; a brother, Charles Brandriet; a sister, Darlene; and a grandson, Jody Brandriet.

Survivors include his wife, Shirley Brandriet of Watertown, S.D.; a son, Randall Brandriet of Pierre, S.D.; two daughters and a son-in-law, Laurie and Ron Keller of Houston and Wendy Barrios of Wa-

tertown, S.D.; two sisters and a brother-in-law, Laretta Fox of Watertown, S.D. and Phyllis and Bob Lindner of Aberdeen, S.D.; three grandchildren, Jay Brandriet, Justin Brandriet and Catherine Barrios; two step-grandchildren, Brad Keller and Allison Keller Smith; and three step-great-grandchildren, Anna Beth Smith, Emily Smith and Meghan Smith.
