Mt. PLEASANT -- Services for Donald Edward Brindley, 68, were held Tuesday, Nov. 19, 2002, at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Mt. Pleasant with the Rev. Octavio Suarez officiating.

Mr. Brindley died Friday, Nov. 15, in Camp County.

He was born June 18, 1934, in Whiting, Ind. and was a graduate of Western Pacific University. He dedicated the later-year of his life to helping alcoholics and drug abusers in their recovery process.
