Mr. Granville Edward
Brown, age 80 of Crockett,
passed away Sunday, August
19, 2001 in the East Texas
Medical Center Crockett.
Mr. Brown was born July 5,
1921 in Fredricksburg and
had lived in Crockett since
1981, previously living in
San Saba, Houston and
Crosby. He married Hazel
D. Dyes on October 2, 1948
and they had two sons. Mr.
Brown retired from South-
western Bell Telephone
Company after 35 years of
service. He was a veteran of
the US Navy, having served
during World War II, and
was also a member of the
First Baptist Church in
Crockett.

Survivors include wife Ha-
zel D. Dyes of Crockett; son
Mark G. Brown, and wife
Nancy of Groves; grandsons
David G. Brown of College
Station, Aaron L. Brown and
Adam J. Brown, of Groves;
brothers Lee Brown of Mag-
