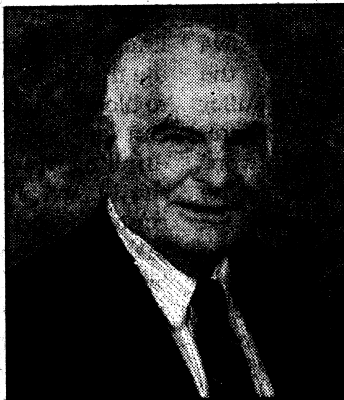

Kennedy "Doc" Brown

Funeral services for Mr. Kennedy "Doc" Brown were held Wednesday, June 2, 2004 at 11:30 a.m. in the Felders Chapel Assembly of God with Rev. Randy Shipman and Rev. James Jackson officiating. Interment followed in the Refuge Cemetery.
