

## Alleta Bybee

COOS BAY, Oregon - Graveside services for Alleta Bybee, 91, of North Bend, Oregon and formerly of Trinity were held at 11:30 a.m. Saturday, May 13, 2006, at the Woodlawn Garden of Memories Cemetery in Houston.

Mrs. Bybee died Thursday, May 4 in North Bend, Oregon.

She was born Dec. 24, 1914 in Eyangeline, La., the daughter of Albert and Bevie (Graham) Meek. She was reared and attended public school in McAllen.
