

S. F. (Bud) Calhoun

Funeral services for Mr. S. F. (Bud) Calhoun, 89, of Palestine were held at p.m. Wednesday at Bailey Memorial Chapel in Palestine with the REv. A. S. Lee of Crockett officiating. Burial was in the Buffalo City Cemetery.

Mr. Calhoun, who formerly ran a store in Palestine, died at 7 a.m. Tuesday at the Palestine Nursing Home. Born in Crockett, he had lived in Palestine the last 17 years. He belonged to the Crockett Presbyterian Church and to the Masonic Lodge in Crockett and to El Mina Shrine Temple in Galveston.
