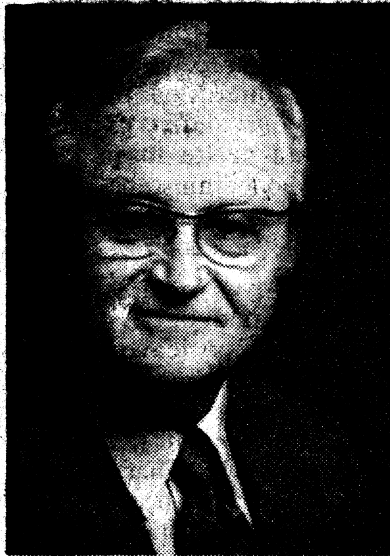

**GUY V. CASKEY**

Mr. Guy V. Caskey, age 85 of Arlington, passed away Wednesday, March 12, 2003. Mr. Caskey was born in Grapeland where he graduated as valedictorian of his high school. Mr. Caskey received additional education at Freed-Hardeman College, Robert E. Lee College and Abilene Christian University. Mr. Caskey was a retired preacher. Mr. Caskey preached for 69 of his 85 years in Dalhart, Pampa, Sweetwater, Fort Worth and Arlington. Mr. Caskey did mission work in Africa and Jamaica where he served as director of schools of Biblical studies. Mr. Caskey began works in several African countries and his travels and speaking carried him to more than 50 nations. Mr. Caskey appeared on lecture programs at many universities and received honors from Abilene Christian University and Caribbean Christian College. The student center at the Jamaica School of Preaching in Kingston is named in his honor and his wife, Jessie Lee. Mr. Caskey

has touched lives and will be remembered by friends from around the world.

Survivors include his wife of 65 years Jessie Lee Caskey; a son who along with his wife is a missionary in the Bahamas; a daughter who with her husband of The Woodlands; three married grandsons; one married granddaughter; three great-grandsons; and a great-granddaughter to be born in the next three months.

Funeral services for Mr. Guy V. Caskey were held Saturday, March 15, at 10:00 a.m. in Arlington Funeral Chapel in Arlington.

Graveside services were held Saturday, March 15 at 3:00 p.m. at Livelyville Cemetery in Grapeland.
