## Nelton D. 'Dee' Chessher

TRINITY - Services for Nelton D. "Dee" Chessher, 65, were held at 2 p.m. Friday, Oct. 1, 2004, at the Trinity Tabernacle Assembly of God Church with the Rev. Roger Goins officiating.
