Mr. Harold Clifton Clark, age 82, of Sugarland, formerly of Belott, passed away April 4 at Methodist Hospital in Houston. Mr. Clark was born Aug. 5, 1916, in Cross Plains, and had been a resident of Sugarland for the past three years.

After his retirement, Mr. Clark and his late wife, Augusta "Gussie" Clark, moved to Belott where they lived for several years.
