Rites Held For Annie Mae Clewis

Services for Annie Mae Clewis, 87, were held Saturday morning, January 20, at St. John Baptist Church, Grapeland, with the Rev. J. T. Session officiating. Burial followed at Golden Gate Cemetery, Grapeland.
