Mr. Charles Terrell Cummings Sr., age 78, of DeSoto, formerly of Crockett, passed away Tuesday, May 1, 2001 in the Charlton Methodist Hospital in DeSoto. Mr. Cummings was born March 21, 1923 in Dialville and had been living in DeSoto for the last three
