GEORGE EDWARD DARSEY III

Mr. George Edward Darsey III, beloved husband, father and grandfather, passed away Tuesday, August 29, 2006 after a six-year battle with Alzheimer's disease. Mr. Darsey was born and raised in Grape-land, where his family operated Darsey's General Store, the oldest family owned business of its kind in Texas. Mr. Darsey was a proud "Aggie," graduating as a distinguished student from Texas A&M with a degree in electrical engineering, later his Masters degree in electrical engineering from SMU in Dallas. During WWII, he served in Germany as a lieutenant with the Army Signal Corps. After the war, he moved to Long Island, New York and worked for Sperry Gyroscope, Co. There he met

and married Dorothy Elam and had three children before moving to Dallas to work for Texas Instruments, from which he retired.

Survivors include his wife Dorothy Elam Darsey; son Robert Wynn Darsey; daughter and son-in-law Deborah Darsey Stern and Dr. Richard L. Stern; grandchildren who were his pride and joy, Alex and Brittny Lamb.
