Services Held For Madge Dauphin, 99

Funeral services for Mrs. Madge Bean Dauphin, age 99, of Grapeland were held Sunday, December 10, 2000, in the First Baptist Church, Grapeland, with Rev. David Bradley and Rev. Kenneth Mobley officiating. Burial followed in Parker Cemetery, northwest of Grapeland, under the direction of Bailey & Foster.
