Services Held For Olan W. Davis

Funeral services for Olan Welborn Davis, 79, of Grapeland were held Friday, March 19, at 4 p.m. in the First Christian Church, Grapeland, with Rev. Jim Brandt and Rev. Andrew Byers officiating. Burial was in the Refuge Cemetery east of Grapeland.

Lifelong resident of Grapeland, Mr. Davis was born January 15, 1886.
