Funeral services were held Saturday, August 18, 2007 for Rev. Carolyn Leigh Davis, 71, in St. John's Cathedral in Denver, Colorado, with the Right Rev. Jerry Winterrowd officiating. Interment followed in St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Lakewood, Colorado. She was born March 18, 1936 in Houston, the daughter of William Harvey Speight and Veral Audra Nunn Speight Poole.

She received degrees in RN, counseling, master of social work and master of divinity. She served as rector at a number of Episcopal churches in Texas and Colorado, all of which she loved dearly. She was rector for St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Livingston from March 15, 1999 until December 30, 2003, when she moved to Center. She subsequently moved back to Colorado.
