

## Tom G. Day

Graveside funeral services for Mr. Tom G. Day, 31, of Rt 5, Lufkin, were held at 3 p.m. Sunday in the Enon Cemetery in eastern Houston County. Rev. O. P. Meador and Rev. Ronney Beams officiated, and burial was in the Enon Cemetery.

Mr. Day was born in Ratcliff Oct. 20, 1932, and had lived in Houston County most of his life before moving to Lufkin two years ago. He was a member of the Baptist church and served in the U.S. Army during the Korean conflict. He was employed as a utility maintenance man at the Lufkin Foundry and Machine Co. for two years. He was killed in a fall.

Survivors include thewife, Mrs. Lula C. Day; his mother, Mrs. W. L. Caples of Jasper; a sister, Mrs. Mollie Lowery of Crockett; a stepbrother, Cecil Caples of Jasper; a stepsister, Mrs. Nettie Luttrell of Crockett.
