

## STEVE POWELL DECKARD

Mr. Steve Powell Deckard. age 79 of Crockett, passed away Saturday, December 14. 2002 in the Crockett Care Center. Mr. Deckard was born June 10, 1923 in Sulphur Springs. Mr. Deckard was a veteran of WWII serving in the U.S. Marines in the South Pacific and after the war, returned to Dallas where he began a long and successful career in the printing supply business.
