Funeral services for Edward Hubbard Denman, 75, of Rt. 3 Grapeland, were held Monday, Sept. 30, at 4 p.m. in the Grapeland Church of Christ with James Mosley officiating. Burial was in the Guiceland Cemetery, Salmon.

Mr. Denman was born December 27, 1892, in Trinity County to the late Mose Denman and Mrs. Ruth Morrison Denman, and died Sunday at 8:15 a. m. in a Palestine nursing home.
