## William Henry Denny

Mr. Denny, a life-long resident, and son of pioneer parents, was an elder of the Presbyterian church, a former director and officer of the Crockett Chamber of Commerce, a member of the Crockett Rotary Club and of Lothrop Lodge No. 21, A.F. and A. M., treasurer of the United Fund of Houston County president of the Crockett State Bank since 1942, and active in banking and insurance business for 40 years.

Funeral services for Mr. Denny were held at 4 p.m. Tuesday from the First Presbyterian Church, with the Rev. Warren Hall, pastor, officiating. Elders and deacons of the church served as active and honorary pallbearers. Interment was in the Evergreen Memorial Park. Waller Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Denny is survived by his wife, Mrs. Beryl Brooks Denny; a daughter, S. T. Denny; and a sister, Miss Grace Denny, all of Crockett.
