Davis O. Denson, Sr., 75 died at 11:30 p.m. Wednesday July 23, at his home in Elkhart following a sudden illness. Funeral services were held Saturday July 26, at 2 p.m. in the Memorial Baptist Church of Elkhart with the Rev. Lloyd Stewart and the Rev. Clint Grant officiating. Burial followed in the Livelyville Cemetery.
