Funeral services for William Edward Denson, 90, of Rt. 3, Grapeland (Mount City Community), were held Wednesday, March 11, at 2 p.m. in the Evergreen Chapel, Percilla, with Rev. H. G. Smith of Troup officiating. Burial followed in Evergreen Cemetery.
