Mrs. Margaret Jane Derrick, 89, of Crockett, died Saturday in a local nursing home.

Funeral services were held at 2:30 p.m. Sunday in the First Methodist Church of Madill, with Rev. V. Clinton Purtell, pastor of the church, officiating. Burial was in the Madill City Cemetery.
