JOHN ROBERT DODSON

Mr. John Robert Dodson, of Austin was born August 30, 1926 and passed away on January 26, 2006. Mr. Dodson was the son of Capp Dodson well known in Crockett as Captain of the CCC at Ratcliff. Mr. Dodson retired from the Naval Reserves after 35 years of service and achieved the rank of commander.
