

Marion Quince Dominy

Mr. Marion Quince Dominy, Sr., 84, passed away in Trinity Memorial Hospital Tuesday, Feb. 26.

Quince, the sixth son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Daniel J. Dominy, was born at Pennington, Sept. 11, 1878, and spent his entire life at the Daniel J. Dominy home with the exception of two years spent in Tucumeari, New Mexico.

He was married to Miss Nolia Holmes in 1911. To this union five chidren were born. His wife, Nolia, preceded him in death in 1958.

Funeral services were held Thursday, Feb. 28, at 2:30 p.m. in the Pennington Baptist Church, with Rev. Gayle A. Hogg, pastor and Rev. J. T. Riley, former pastor, officiating. Miss Mary Nelms was the organist and Miss Margarette Stevenson of Dallas was the soloist. He was a member of the Pennington Baptist Church since 1911.
